A yearly national day, celebrated the first Saturday of the month of July (this year the 7-7-2007), is dedicated to TABBOULEH.

The TABBOULEH is the most famous Lebanese traditional dish, adulated by all the inhabitants of the cedar's country, and adopted by number of gastronomes in the world.
